Best Start Assessment

Best Start assessments will take place over Weeks 2 and 3 in Term 1, Monday 10 - Friday 21 February 2025. These will be held in the Kindergarten classrooms.

2025 Kindergarten First Day

The first day for Kindergarten 2025 will be **Thursday 6 February 2025**. On this day children are to arrive at 9.30 am. Children will be given name tags and can meet with teachers and buddies outside the classroom area. Children will be presented with their new school hat from their buddies. Parents are asked to make a happy and quick departure to make it easier for the children. Children are to be collected from the hall at 1.45 pm.

An early finish to the day is encouraged for the first 2 weeks in Kindergarten. Children must be collected from the hall at 1.45 pm and signed out.

The first full day for your child will commence on **Monday 24 February 2025**. Commencing at 8.45am through to 2.45pm.

The P&C will hold a Kindergarten mix and mingle on Friday 14 February between 1.45 and 2.45pm.
