POSIFY POSITIVE EDUCATION

Last week staff participated in a three hour professional learning session with the directors from Posify.



Posify educates adults and children in positive behaviour.

“Motivated to boost wellbeing in our communities, we seek to inspire and educate others about the positive psychology principles of purpose so that together, we can all craft our most meaningful lives.

Drawing on the science of happiness and wellbeing, we unpack the practical ways individuals and teams can craft their own purpose projects, whilst gaining skills to improve their wellbeing and boost their optimism”.

Staff engaged in an afternoon of discussion and workshopped positive wellbeing practices at Lake Cathie Public School.

As a staff we aim to strengthen the already positive practices and procedures in place.

One part of the school plan relates to wellbeing practices and promoting positive wellbeing for students and staff.

On Tuesday last week Stage 3 participated in a full day leadership day where they worked collaboratively to learn about wellbeing, focusing on positive emotions, engagement, relationships, meaning and accomplishment.

A great deal of research reveals the benefits of promoting the development of purpose and leadership growth among young people. Students who learn how to lean in to their unique set of skills, strengths and interests are more likely to contribute positively to their communities, schools and wider society, and accomplish greater achievements in adulthood.

Both staff and students enjoyed learning about ways they can boost their wellbeing and focus on positive behaviour practices.

The purpose of the conference is to connect high-quality educations from around the world with Australian educators and promote future-focused, best-practices. This year, the conference will be held at Banora Point and will bring together 600 educators from Australia and New Zealand. This conference is very relevant to the work being undertaken here at Lake Cathie Public School where teachers have recently experienced professional learning with The Posify Group (focused on student leadership and positive habits of the mind), setting learning goals and giving/receiving feedback. These are skills and mindsets needed to develop happy and successful citizens.

NAPLAN ONLINE - SCHOOL READINESS TEST FOR YEAR 3 AND YEAR 5

The School Readiness Test for NAPLAN will take place from August 20 - 7 September 2018. This test allows schools to become familiar with the Online Assessment Platform and to identify any technical or administrative issues that need to be resolved prior to moving online. The school will not receive any information about students' results as this is purely a technical/organisation tool for schools. It is not a test of student performance.

The school readiness test consists of two assessments:

1. An omnibus test that includes reading, conventions of language and numeracy (Year 3 and 5)
2. A writing task (Year 5 only)

If you do not wish for your child to be involved, please contact your child's classroom teacher prior to Friday 24 August 2018.

TELL THEM FROM ME SURVEYS - FOR STUDENTS

This term, our school, like many other public schools in the state, will participate in a Department of Education initiative: the Tell Them From Me student feedback survey. The survey measures factors that are known to affect academic achievement and other student outcomes. The focus of the NSW-wide survey is on student wellbeing, engagement and effective teaching practices.

You may remember that our students also participated in a Tell Them From Me student survey in Term 1 this year. Asking students to

complete the survey twice in one year allows us to identify trends in student responses as well as track engagement and motivation across the school year. The survey is a great opportunity for our students to provide us with valuable and quick feedback on what they think about school life, how engaged they are with school and the different ways that teachers interact with them. More than 6,300 schools in Australia and around the world have used Tell Them From Me to survey 5.4 million students. Capturing the voices of our students will help improve how we do things at our school. More information about the survey is available at:

The survey is confidential. It is conducted online and will typically take less than 30 minutes to complete. It will be administered during school hours between 27 August and 26 October. Participating in the survey is entirely voluntary. A consent form and FAQs for parents/carers about the survey is being sent home with students. If you do not want your child or children to participate, please return the form to school by Friday 24 August 2018.



TELL THEM FROM ME - PARENT SURVEY

This Term, our school will be participating in the Partners in Learning parent survey, another part of the Tell Them From Me suite of surveys (student, teacher and parent surveys) on student engagement. The survey asks parents and carers questions about different factors that are known to impact on student wellbeing and engagement.

Running this survey will help our school understand parents' and carers' perspectives on their child's experience at school. These include: communication between parents/carers and staff, activities and practices at home and parent/carer views on the school's support of learning and behaviour. This valuable feedback will help our school make practical improvements.

The survey is conducted entirely online on smartphones, ipads, tablets, laptops or computers. The survey will typically take 15 minutes or less to complete and is completely confidential. The parent survey will be conducted between 27 August and 26 October. Although participating in the survey is entirely voluntary, your responses are very much appreciated. NATIONAL LITERACY AND NUMERACY LEARNING PROGRESSIONS

Staff are currently engaging in professional learning related to the implementation of the new national literacy and numeracy learning progressions.

The learning progressions will replace the literacy and numeracy continuums.

The learning progressions are a tool to support students in

accessing the literacy and numeracy capabilities required across all learning areas.

Learning progressions:

- assist in strengthening teacher knowledge and facilitate a shared understanding of literacy and numeracy development
- assists teachers to differentiate teaching and learning experiences and to provide feedback to students about next steps in learning
- are to be used in conjunction with the syllabuses, which remain the focus for planning, programming, teaching, learning and assessment and reporting to parents.

Teachers will monitor student growth in line with the learning progressions to help support the teaching and learning occurring in the classrooms.

Literacy and numeracy learning progressions will be implemented from the start of 2019.

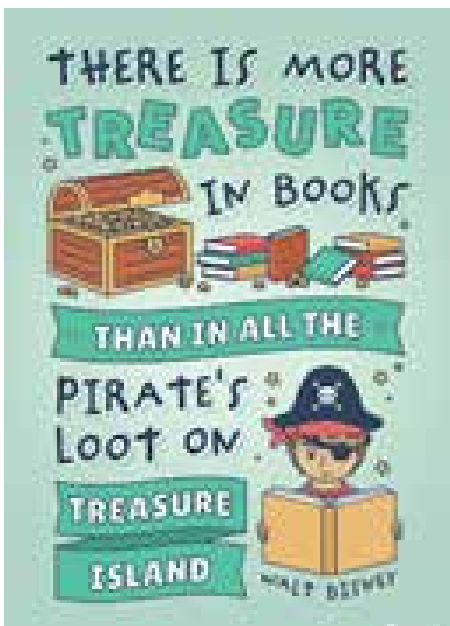

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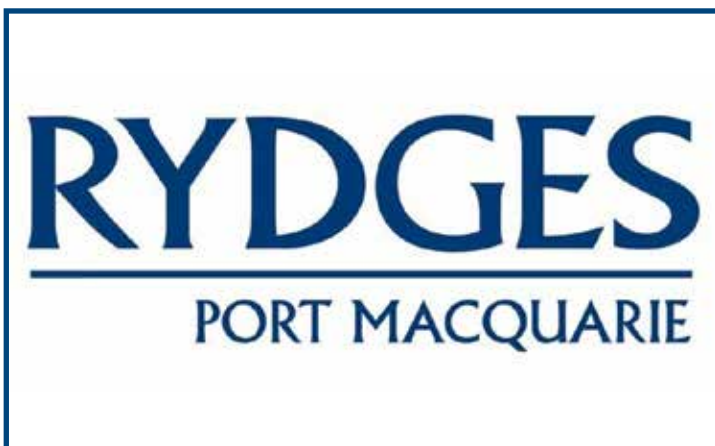
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
