#### **TREE SAFETY**

In line with our recent Annual Tree Safety Audit, new trees will be installed in our central courtyard during the school holidays replacing the Chinese Tallowood that we were asked to have removed by the Department of Education's Asset Management Unit and Health and Safety Directorate. The replacement trees, "Luscious" as we have behind the library, have been on order and have finally arrived.

The large habitat tree on the way into school has been scheduled for removal soon. The habitat boxes will be relocated to a nearby tree. Termites have continued to attack this tree and arborists will remove it in the coming weeks.

#### STUDENT REPORTS

Next week we will provide a simplified written report outlining students' learning in Semester 1. Due to the significant changes in all of our students' lives this year, we will be reporting to parents/carers with the focus on the learning that has taken place so far this year. This will include student's progress and effort, as well as areas for development based on the variety of observations and assessments undertaken both face to face and through the blended online learning at home.

As indicated by the Department of Education, the grading of students using the five point A-E scale is not required. Principals and teachers have worked with their colleagues across the Hastings Valley Community of Schools to come up with a consistent reporting template to share student effort and learning with their parents and carers. We envisage a return to a full report on each student's learning at the end of Semester 2 as is usual practise.



# NATIONALLY CONSISTENT COLLECTION OF DATA

As mentioned in previous years, students with a confirmed disability, physically or mentally, are required to be identified on a national data collection register called the NCCD. Details of personal information are held confidentially in line with national privacy regulations and are used to assist Government initiatives and support mechanisms for students with a disability. Collection of this data is finalised early next term. This process is conducted by the Principal, counsellor, class teachers and the Learning and Support teacher. No action is required by parents. What a fun way to raise money. Well done Lake Cathie Public School.




















